Comenius

What is Comenius ?

- This programme allows exchanges and cooperation between schools from different EU countries and partners. Individuals (students and staff) can also apply to individual grants.

Comenius's objectives :

- Improve and increase the mobility of pupils and educational staff across the EU
- Favor the personal development and skills of participants, especially linguistic
- Give them a better understanding of European citizenship and multiculturalism
- Enhance and increase partnerships between schools in different EU Member States;
- Encourage language learning, innovative ICT-based content, services and better teaching techniques and practices;
- Enhance the quality and European dimension of teacher training;
- Improve pedagogical approaches and school management

For who ?

- The Comenius programme focuses on all levels of school education, from pre-school and primary to secondary schools.
- It is relevant for everyone involved in school education: mainly pupils and teachers but also local authorities, representatives of parents' associations, non-government organizations, teacher training institutes and universities.

How to participate ?

- To participate in a Comenius programme, you have to contact your national European Agency of Education and Formation where a person in charge of the project will help you.

Participating countries ?

- The 27 member states of the EU and Turkey, Iceland ,Liechtenstein, Norway.

Duration

- The term depends on the project and can vary between a few days to two years.
- Figures in France (in 2011):
 - 1885 projects received a grant (52% of total applications)
 - 13,737,437€

More information :

- In 2011 there were 2290 applications.
- The financing had reached 2 564 956 € for the continuous training grant

ERASMUS



What is Erasmus ?

- ERAMUS is a European student exchange programme. This programme proposes two types of mobilities:
 - - Study : a student can complete part of his studies in a European higher education institution. The degrees and marks gained abroad are validated in the ECTS (European Credit Transfer System).
 - - Internship : allows students to gain experience in a European company during their studies.

Erasmus' objectives :

- improve and increase the mobility of students
- improve the independence and autonomy of students
- enhance their language skills
- allow another vision of education
- extend students' culture

For who ?

- ❑ Any student registered in an Institution of higher education during the year of mobility can apply to an Erasmus grant.

How to participate ?

- You have to address the international relations department of your university eight to nine months before the desired mobility date.

Participating countries ?

- The 27 member states of the EU and Turkey, Iceland ,Liechtenstein, Norway.

Duration :


- - Studying abroad: between 3 months to 1 year
- -Internship: between 2 months to 1 year
- Figures in France (in 2010) :
 - 749 projects (95% of applications)

Erasmus's scholarship

- ❑ -Studying abroad: about 150 € per month.
- ❑ -Internship : about 350 € per month.

Leonardo da Vinci

What is the Leonardo Da Vinci programme ?

- The Leonardo da Vinci programme is one of the sectoral programmes of Education and training throughout life.
- It is designed as a tool responsible for giving impetus to education systems and vocational education in Europe in their diversity.
- It enables the mobility of people wishing to gain work experience in Europe.
- It facilitates the exchange of good practices between training and is also a lever of choice to implement new tools and training methods in order to extend their application to the European level.

Leonardo Da Vinci's objectives :

- - Help people concerning by training and vocational education
- -Support innovations and development of educational systems and training
- -Encourage the competitiveness of the European labor market
- -Increase the quality and attractiveness of vocational education and training in Europe

Programme activities:

- - Mobility projects : For an internship in a European company
- - Partnership projects: To forge cooperation with actors of European vocational training around a common theme.
- - Transfer of Innovation projects : To develop, through transfer, use and appropriation of tools and methods training across Europe.

For who ?

- Leonardo Da Vinci is a European programme for job seekers, young graduates, employees in training and apprentices.

Duration :

- -Project about innovation development and transfer of innovation : 12, 18 or 24 months.
- -Mobility projects :
 - placement of young people in initial training : 2-39 weeks
 - People who want a first vocational experience : 2-26 weeks
 - Trainers or vocational teachers : 1-6 weeks
- -Preparatory visits : 1 week

Participating countries?

- ❑ The 27 member states of the EU and Turkey, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway.

Leornardo Da Vinci's scholarship :

- -30 to 130 € per week, it depends of indemnity (can't exceed 762 €)
- Payment of a round trip to the host country within the limit of 550 €.
- - Aid for language training: 250 €.

PEJA

- What is it?

A European programme which allows young people to participate in diverse activities concerning European Union values.

- Duration : from two days to one year.
- Who ? : people from 13 to 30 and education professionals.
- Where ? : in the 27 countries of the European Union + Island, Norway, Lichtenstein and Turkey.

EURODYSSEE

- What is it ? :

A regional programme which gives the opportunity to job-seekers, from 18 to 30 who live in the area of Champagne-Ardennes to have a professional experience in a company in Europe.

- Duration : from 2 to 6 months + 1 month of language class.

- Who ? : job-seekers.

- Where ? : more than 20 regions of Europe.

ETWINNING

- What is it ? :

A European website aimed at bringing schools throughout Europe together for educational projects.

- Who ? : students and teachers

- Where ? : in the 27 countries of the European Union.
